



Rehabilitative & Community Support Program

ELIGIBILITY

Services are accessible to children ages birth to 21 who have MaineCare or MaineCare Katie Beckett coverage, a behavioral health diagnosis, and a current assessment documenting a functional impairment.

SERVICE AREA

The RCS Program provides services in many parts of Southern and Central Maine. Please reach out to ask about service availability in your area.

Woodfords' Rehabilitative & Community Support Program provides one-on-one support to children with intellectual and developmental disabilities so that they may become active participants in both family and community life.

A Behavioral Health Professional (BHP) works with the child in their home and/or community on specific goals to increase their skills in behavior management, communication, independent living, self-care, self-help and socialization.

The Rehabilitative and Community Support Program also offers specialized services for children in need of more intensive treatment. A Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) develops the treatment plan for children receiving this service, goals are based on the evidence-based principles and practices of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA).
